

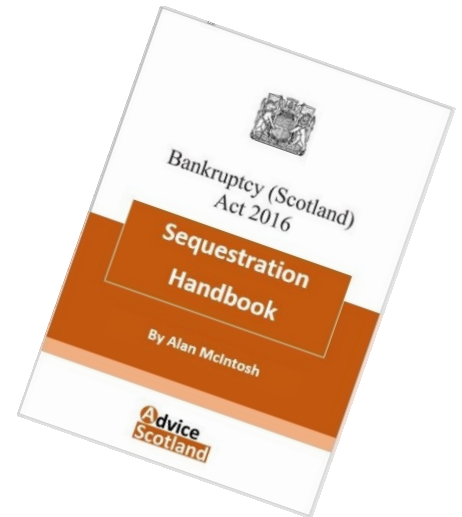
# Sequestration
